COME TO THE STONE MUSIC AND ARTS FESTIVAL...

A VERY WARM WELCOME to the programme for the fourth **STONE MUSIC AND ARTS FESTIVAL** which takes place from **9th to 15th of July 2012**. This year our weekend events will commence on Friday 13th July with an exciting launch event in The Crown Hotel Ballroom, when we are delighted to announce that the fantastic Jimi Hendrix tribute band **ARE YOU EXPERIENCED?** will be performing a vibrant set featuring a rich selection of the guitar great's wonderful and innovative repertoire.

The festival will continue over the weekend with music which will appeal to all tastes and ages. This year we have not two, but four headline bands appearing on the two stages over the weekend!

The Saturday events will be opened by our ever popular busking competition, with the usual generous prizes for first, second and third places. As part of our ever-expanding remit to improve the quality of the festival experience for the people of Stone, we are pleased to announce that we have two stages in operation this year on the festival Sunday enabling us to maximise the amount of music and performances. The Saturday stage is in Market Square, and this stage will remain there for the duration of the weekend to augment the main stage at the top of High Street.

This year, as well as the usual array of top quality cover and tribute bands, we have incorporated more bands in the line-up who will perform their own material to showcase the amazing amount of rich and original musical talent in the Stone and Staffordshire area. The 'official' opening event is Are You Experienced? at The Crown Hotel, but you are sure to find a veritable potpourri of excellent musical entertainment in Stone in the days leading up to that as many of the pubs in the town enter into the festival spirit.

Our Saturday event will culminate in an exciting and energetic indie music based performance from well known tribute act **KMK - THE KAISER MONKEY KILLERS**. Top notch glam-rock tribute band, **SLYDE** will close proceedings for the Saturday.

The magnificent Sunday finale to last year's festival was of course a stunning performance by Roxy Magic, and anyone who witnessed their superb, polished performance will never forget it. Even over a year later, this is clearly a hard act to follow. We think we've succeeded though - as after a top quality set of rock and pop covers from local heroes **THE VANZ**, we are delighted to welcome **RE-TAKE THAT** who will close the festival with what promises to be an fantastic finale to the week's events.

The festival voluntary group has been hugely fortunate in again securing the support of **WEDGWOOD** whom we sincerely thank for sponsoring the event. A very special event to celebrate this sponsorship will be this year's classical concert starring **DUNCAN HONEYBOURNE**, a classical pianist of enormous repute who is renowned throughout the British Isles as a performer of the highest calibre. 


